Description (max 200 words)	The Czech for Foreigners Portal provides an overview and comprehensive information for foreigners who are applying for permanent residence in the Czech Republic or for Czech citizenship and will be taking the Czech Language Exam or Czech Life and Institutions Exam.
Methodology (max 150 words)	<p>The Czech for Foreigners portal comprises the website Permanent Residence and Citizenship and a part devoted to registered users.</p> <p>The Permanent Residence website provides information for foreigners as well as for examiners and the general public. It is possible to find basic information about the exam on the website, i.e., when and where it is taking place, what it costs to take, what it contains and what are the terms and conditions for taking it. Interested parties can try out a model (sample) test and download information and study materials for the exam. The website also includes basic information about applying for permanent residence in the Czech Republic. The section for examiners contains more detailed information in the columns and other modules for registered users.</p> <p>The Citizenship website provides information for Czech citizenship applicants. The General Information section includes information about the primary legislation related to granting Czech citizenship, general information about the</p>

	<p>exam, i.e., when and where it is taking place, what it costs to take, what it contains and what are the terms and conditions for taking it. The Czech Life and Institutions Exam section is a detailed guide to the exam, include the applicable rules, exam specifications and interactive sample test. This website also provides links to the on-line exam application.</p>
